Our Neighborhood

The Prescott Oakland Point neighborhood is one of the oldest residential and commercial areas in Oakland. It became home to a diverse community of Europeans, Mexicans, Asians, and African Americans. Most of the houses are historic Victorians built between 1860 and 1900. Oakland Point, was the terminus of the first transcontinental railroad and is one of the most intact Victorian districts in the state. It remains a thriving socially and ethnically mixed neighborhood, and is centrally located minutes from the San Francisco-Oakland Bay Bridge, and Highways 580, 880, 980, and 24.
